Ephesians 2:10

Psalm 96:3

Declare his glory among the nations,

Philippians 4:12-13

3. Courageous

Joshua 1:9

Have I not commanded you?
Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified;
do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God
will be with you wherever you go.

4. Decisive

Romans 14:12-13

So then, each of us will give an account
of himself to God. Therefore let us stop passing
judgment on one another. Instead, make up your
mind not to put any stumbling block
or obstacle in your brother's way.

5. Dependable

Deuteronomy 23:23a

Whatever your lips utter you must be sure to do,
because you made your vow freely to the
LORD your God with your own mouth.

6. Diligent

Romans 12:10-13

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love.
Honor one another above yourselves.
Never be lacking in zeal, but keep
your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.
Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction,
faithful in prayer. Share with God's people
who are in need. Practice hospitality.

7. Enthusiastic

Colossians 3:23

Whatever you do,
work at it with all your heart,
as working for the Lord, not for men.

8. Faithful

Proverbs 3:3

Let love and faithfulness never leave you;
bind them around your neck,
write them on the tablet of your heart.

9. Generous

1 Timothy 6:18-19

Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.

Proverbs 15:1

1 Corinthians 12:28

Proverbs 12:17

13. Hopeful

Romans 15:13

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

14. Humble

Titus 3:2

...to slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and to show true humility toward all men.

15. Joyful

1 Thessalonians 5:16-17

Be joyful always; pray continually;

Ephesians 4:32

Galatians 6:5
